ORDINANCE NO. 448

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 19, 2018, the City Council of the City of Arvin adopted Ordinance No. 448, entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARVIN AMENDING CHAPTER 17.56 (“CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS”) OF TITLE 17 (“ZONING”) OF THE ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD COMMERCIAL CANNABIS BUSINESSES AS A CONDITIONALLY PERMITTED USE IN SPECIFIC ZONES AND TO ADD EXPRESS PROCEDURES FOR SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS

SUMMARY

The Ordinance adds commercial cannabis businesses as a conditionally permitted use within the specified zones in the city limits. The Ordinance provides the process by which a conditional use permit will be grant by the City and the appeals and revocation procedures for said conditional use permit. Further, the Ordinance is purely ministerial in that it establishes the administrative processes and regulations governing the issuing of conditional use permit for Commercial Cannabis Businesses.
