**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ARVIN AMENDING AND RENUMBERING CHAPTER 17.62  
("COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITY") OF TITLE 17 OF THE  
ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE AND THEREBY ADDING CHAPTER  
17.64 ("COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITY") TO TITLE 17 OF  
THE ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH  
COMPREHENSIVE REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO  
COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITY**

**SUMMARY**

The proposed Ordinance amends and renumbers Title 17, Section 17.62 and adds Section 17.64 ("Commercial Cannabis Activity") which defines and regulates the commercial cannabis activity related uses that are to be allowed in the City. The ordinance clarifies and establishes a comprehensive set of regulations governing all aspects of commercial cannabis activities. A Distributor is licensed by the State of California to distribute commercial cannabis and commercial cannabis products to wholesale purchases. It also amends the Arvin Municipal Code to allow non-storefront dispensaries within the City. Further the Ordinance amends and refines definitions, the work permit approval process, inspections and enforcement, violations, insurance coverage limits and application review and approval procedures.
