**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on January 22, 2019, at 5:00 pm, or as soon after as the matter may be heard, the City Council of the City of Arvin intends to adopt an Ordinance, entitled:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF ARVIN, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING APPENDIX A TO  
CHAPTER 1.24 OF THE ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE  
RELATING TO THE CITY'S CONFLICT OF INTEREST  
CODE.**

**SUMMARY**

The Political Reform Act requires the City to review its conflict of interest code biennially. The proposed Ordinance amends the Arvin Municipal Code to update the list of designated positions that are subject to the City's conflict of interest code. The proposed Ordinance update includes a new position since the last amendment and deletes the titles of positions that have been abolished or that no longer make or participate in making governmental decisions.
