NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR SUBMITTAL OF STATE CDBG APPLICATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Arvin will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, February 12, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. at Arvin City Council Chambers, 200 Campus Drive, Arvin, CA 93203, in order to submit under 2018 State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and to solicit citizen input.

The City of Arvin is applying for a grant, in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 and does not anticipate seeking the approval of expendable program income. Arvin is not seeking supplemental activities and does not have existing program income.

The City of Arvin is seeking \$2,872,137 under the General component for Public Improvements/Infrastructure to demolish and rebuild Franklin Street which serves the entire City of Arvin and its residents.

The City of Arvin is also applying for \$100,000 under the Planning/Technical Assistance component for an Economic Development Plan.

The purpose of this public hearing will be to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known on the proposed activities.
