**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ARVIN, CALIFORNIA TO  
AMEND SECTION 5.05.020 OF CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5, ADD  
SECTION 5.05.230 OF CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5 OF THE ARVIN  
MUNICIPAL CODE AND TO ADOPT TITLE 5, CHAPTER 6 OF  
THE ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING SIDEWALK  
VENDORS**

**SUMMARY**

The State of California has recently enacted S.B. No. 946, codified as Government Code sections 51036 through 51039, known as the “Safe Sidewalk Vending Act.” Consistent with State law, the proposed City Ordinance updates requirements for local regulation of sidewalk vending, based on proposed time, place, and manner restrictions directly related to objective health, safety, or welfare concerns. These include requirements for a vending and business license, sales tax reporting, standards for stationary and roaming sidewalk operations, establishment of additional operational standards in public parks, and setting of penalties for violations.
