TITLE 2 OF THE ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE
COMPOSITION OF PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS**

SUMMARY

The proposed ordinance would allow electors living within the City limits, as well as the City's sphere of influence, to be appointed to serve on the Planning Commission. Commissioners from these areas would have a greater interest in the growth and expansion of development within the City and its sphere of influence as compared to persons residing elsewhere. The proposed ordinance will also ensure that the City Council will have a larger pool of potential participants in the Planning Commission, and hence the City's business. The ordinance would also affirm the appointments of any member of the Planning Commission made since the beginning of the year who is living in the sphere of influence.
