

**NOTICE BY THE ARVIN CITY COUNCIL
OF ITS INTENT TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on May 12, 2020 at 6:00 pm, or as soon after as the matter may be heard, the City Council of the City of Arvin intends to adopt an Ordinance, entitled:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ARVIN ADDING CHAPTER 17.65, OF TITLE 17 HEMP TO THE
ARVIN MUNICIPAL CODE**

SUMMARY

The proposed ordinance consists of a regulatory ordinance establishing Chapter 17.65, of Title 17 Hemp which regulates hemp activities in the City of Arvin, including authorizing cultivation, processing and manufacturing of hemp and/or hemp products for commercial and/or scientific/educational purposes. The ordinance also requires hemp cultivators, processors and manufactures to receive a permit issued by the City of Arvin or enter into a development agreement with the City of Arvin prior to beginning any hemp activities within the city limits. Hemp cultivation, processing and manufacturing must comply with all state, federal and local laws governing said activities. All hemp activities must comply with the odor control requirements established by the ordinance. Lastly, any violations of the provisions of this ordinance are subject to criminal and civil penalties. In addition, violations of this ordinance are subject to administrative fines in the amount of \$1,000.00 per violation and per day each violation remains.
